Flying Fifteen Classic and Silver National Championships 12th/13th September 2026

NOTICE OF RACE

(1) The Flying Fifteen National Championships for Classic and Silver classes will be held at Llangorse Lake, Brecon on Saturday - Sunday 12th - 13th September 2026. The organising authority is Llangorse Sailing Club.

(2) Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in The World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028

(3) Competitors will be temporary members of Llangorse Sailing Club for the duration of the event and by entering, agree to be governed by the Club Rules.

(4) The National Championship is for Flying Fifteen Classic and Silver Fleet class.

(5) Racing is scheduled as follows:

Number of Races to count 4 out of 5

If 4, or fewer races are sailed, there will be no discard.

Briefing: 1200 noon Saturday 12th September 2026

Start times Saturday:

Race 1 1300hrs

Race 2 & 3 will be run back-to-back after Race 1

Start times Sunday:

Race 4 1030hrs

Race 5 Back- to-back after Race 4

(6) The addition of any other races over the weekend will not be part of the championships but may be offered at the discretion of the Race Management Team if time and resources permit.

(7) Competitors will enter by completing the official entry form and paying the fee of £25 per boat and agreeing to the following:

(8) The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, howsoever caused to the owner/competitor or crew because of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his/her boat for the race or races. The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the boat.

(9) Registration will commence at 1030 hrs on Saturday 12th September 2026. The Warning signal for the first race will be made not before 1255 hrs

(10) Sailing Instructions will be available at the time of registration.

(11) Prizes will be given for the first three places in each fleet. Trophies will be awarded to the first placed boat in each fleet. In addition, a special prize will be awarded to the first placed boat in the first race on Sunday.

Catering

(12) Cakes and tea/coffee will be available after Saturday racing for £2. Bacon baps will be available Sunday morning before racing for £1.50. Other snacks available in the galley. Payments by cash or card.

(13) A 2-course evening meal will be available on Saturday evening in the club house, with a complimentary glass of wine for £15. Please order and pay for this meal at the Entry Registration desk. To assist in planning the catering, please indicate if you wish to come to the dinner on the entry form. As we don't have a licensed bar you may wish to bring further refreshments for the evening!

Please let us know on your booking form if you are a vegan/vegetarian or have any other dietary requirements as alternative options will be provided.

Access to the club

(14) The main gate to the club grounds is kept locked. However access will be arranged for boats to be brought to the club on the afternoon of Friday 11th

September and removed on the morning of Monday 14th September. Further details will be provided to all entrants.
